

STANDARDS EXPLAINED

Freshcare Standards are presented in the same format for ease of use and referencing criteria.

The infographic below explains the layout to help you identify the different components that are included to support the essential compliance criteria and supporting information including examples of records required.

Records

The Records column is added to assist in identifying records and evidence that could be used to demonstrate compliance to the specified criteria.

Examples provided in the Records column will include references to Freshcare Forms (e.g. Form – M1 Scope) or other evidence that may be required (e.g. Training certificate or test results).

Standard Element

The Standard Element references each section of the Standard. The Standard Element also starts the numbering for each compliance criteria item.

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Standard Element Summary

The summary statement identifies the outcomes to be achieved from the completion of the Compliance Criteria for that Standard Element.

Compliance Criteria

The Compliance Criteria are specific requirements that need to be met in order to demonstrate compliance to the Standard Elements.

Information Section

The information icon highlights references to Freshcare and External Resources at the end of each Standard Element.

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The Freshcare Resources provides references to the Appendix, Factsheets, and other useful documents published by Freshcare (e.g. Freshcare Crop List).

External Resources

The External Resources provides reference to useful industry resources and website links.
